Kids Crew Playgroup	£6,000	Aberdeen City	This grant will enable the group to install a new sensory garden and buy a range of sensory toys and equipment.
The Sunnybank Community Centre Association	£10,000	Aberdeen City	This grant will allow the group to set up a series of family workshops and activities for local families with young children.
Ormiston Inveresk and Salton Residents Association	£4,840	Angus	This group will use the funding to hire arts and crafts tutors for their youth club. The project will benefit approximately 40 children.
Tarbert and Skipness Community Council	£8,829	Argyll and Bute	This grant will enable the group to install a 'little gym' next to the existing adult gym in Tarbert Harbour.
Edinburgh Carrick Knowe Parish Church	£9,743	City of Edinburgh	This grant will allow the organisation to support families with young children through a series of workshops and activities including gardening, crafts and cooking.
Oak Note SCIO	£9,600	City of Edinburgh	This grant will be used to deliver a series of shows and workshops to early years and primary school groups around Scotland.
Saheliya	£8,786	City of Edinburgh	This grant will enable the organisation to run a 30 week play project for children.
Hawkhill Community Association	£9,978	Clackmannanshire	This grant will allow the group to run a free afternoon homework club for local children under eight years of age which will be supervised by retired teachers and classroom assistants.
Dundee Repertory Theatre Ltd	£10,000	Dundee City	This grant will be used to provide dance lessons to three nurseries in Dundee and a family centre in Angus allowing up to 400 children to take part.
Gullane Playgroup	£10,000	East Lothian	This grant will be used to buy a range of outdoor equipment and to help to create a new play area.
Peter Potter Gallery	£9,972	East Lothian	This grant will allow the group to deliver a series of artistic workshop sessions to local families.
Giffnock Soccer Centre	£5,049	East Renfrewshire	This grant will allow the organisation to run an 'Adventure Football' programme to encourage pre school children and help promote physical activity.
Fallin Nursery and Out of School Care	£1,000	Falkirk	This project will encourage further parent and child interaction and will develop children's speech and language skills.
Methilhill Community Children's Initiative Ltd	£9,100	Fife	This grant will allow the group to continue providing a range of activities for over 350 local children.
3D Drumchapel	£9,727	Glasgow City	This project will encourage families to play with children and other local families, and will benefit up to 600 children in the area.
The Children's Wood	£6,375	Glasgow City	This grant will allow the group to run a series of play sessions with under fives and children from Primary 1 - 3. The funding means they will also be able to host a family celebration event over the summer months.

Eczema Outreach (Scotland)	£10,000	Highland	This grant will be used to develop a programme of practical and emotional support groups and events for families of young children aged under 8 years with eczema in Moray and the Highlands.
Everything Baby Highland	£9,920	Highland	This group provides a range of high quality affordable baby and maternity clothes for local families. The grant will allow the organisation to run five new activities for local families.
Seaboard Film Society	£9,492	Highland	This project will allow the group to set up a virtual cinema to provide film screenings in three new locations in Tain.
Fullarton Community Association	£9,231	North Ayrshire	This project will enhance the health and wellbeing of local families by introducing a series of new ventures such as an I.T club and gardening club. The group will also host a family fun day.
